- 12% free and reduced lunch
- 13% eligible for special education
- 19% eligible for reading services
- 13% eligible for gifted services

#### **SPECIAL EDUCATION**

- Serves 78 students with learning disabilities, emotional behavioral disorders, speech/language impaired, physical/hearing/visual impaired, cognitive delays and/or autism who reside in our attendance area
- Provides district-wide Setting 3 program for seven students with autism (ASD)

#### **KIDS CLUB**

- Provides before and after school child care for 126 children
- Provides morning kindergarten extension (K-Time) for nine children

## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS**

- **Reading Program:** CERF Reading Program serves 115 students in reading
- **Gifted Services Program:** Provides service to 80 students in grades K-5
- **English Language Learners (ESL) Program:** Provides services for students requiring additional assistance learning and maintaining the English language
- **Extraordinary Parent Volunteer Program:** 250-300 volunteers provide approximately 4,300 hours of service with children at school
- **Mentoring Program:** Matches up students with staff members
- **Groups:** Social skills groups facilitated by school psychologist, such as friendship groups and family change groups

## **LIBRARY (Media Center)**

19,228 books in collection  
22,859 books checked out per year

2010: New ceiling and lighting installed in media center.

2004: Complete restoration of 10 classrooms in the media wing including new floors, permanent walls, doors and adaptations to the electrical and technical infrastructure. Renovation of media center: new carpeting and shelving, two enhanced areas for student learning, and other aesthetic upgrades.

2002: Replaced heating units and added air conditioning to classrooms. Installed high-efficiency energy management system. Replaced ceilings and lighting in two-thirds of the classrooms. Replaced tile floors and entryways, renovated office space, added storage dock, and renovated kitchen and cafeteria.
